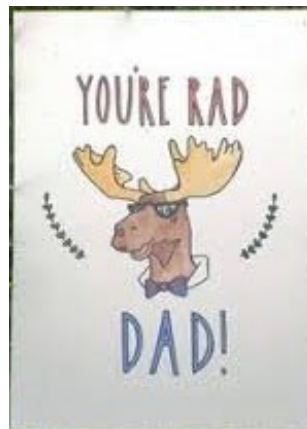

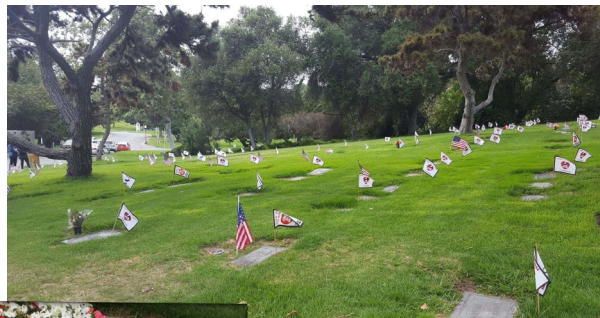

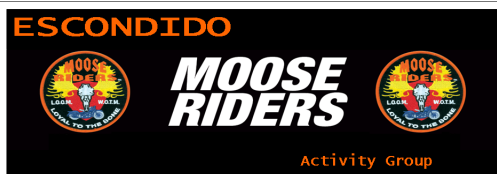

We've had a couple unofficial rides this month with Extreme South. We also had a nice ride up to Idyllwild on Saturday.

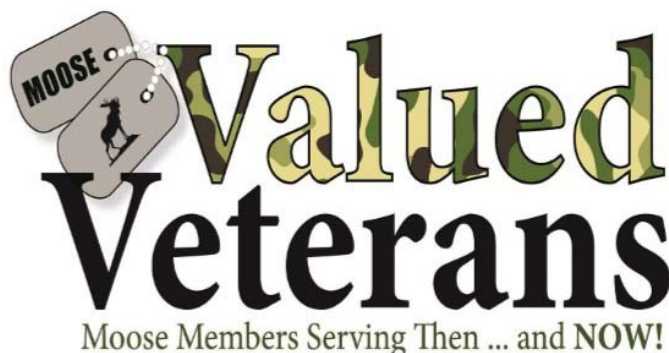
