What's Happening with the Moose Riders?

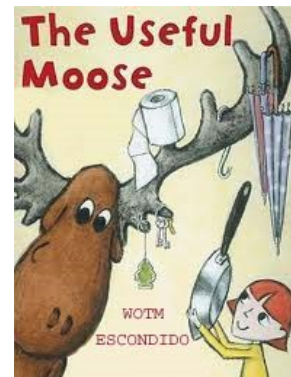
