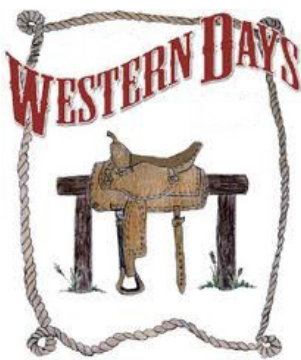

Our Labor Day picnic will be held on September 2nd. (See flyer for details)

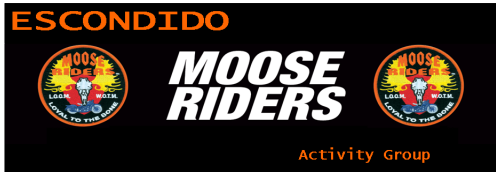
We are looking for cooks for our Friday night dinners. They don't have to be FANCY, they just have to be cooked with LOVE and they will be perfect.

Utility Bill Woes?

If you opened your recent utility bill, like so many of us, you probably were in for a shock. If you are Veteran, Active Duty, Guard or a Reservist and you find yourself short on food in your pantry, there is help out in the community.

Locally, you can visit the Salvation Army on Centre City or you can go to Courage to Call's Food Distribution. They distribute food, twice monthly, at various locations in the county, the second Saturday of the month and on the fourth Saturday they are located at 9445 Farnham St, San Diego 92123. Must present your Military/Veteran ID and bring your own reusable bags. It is first come, first serve and starts at 10am on 8/25/18. Once you register, you are sent emails to let you know where the next food distribution will be.

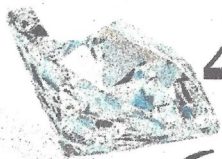

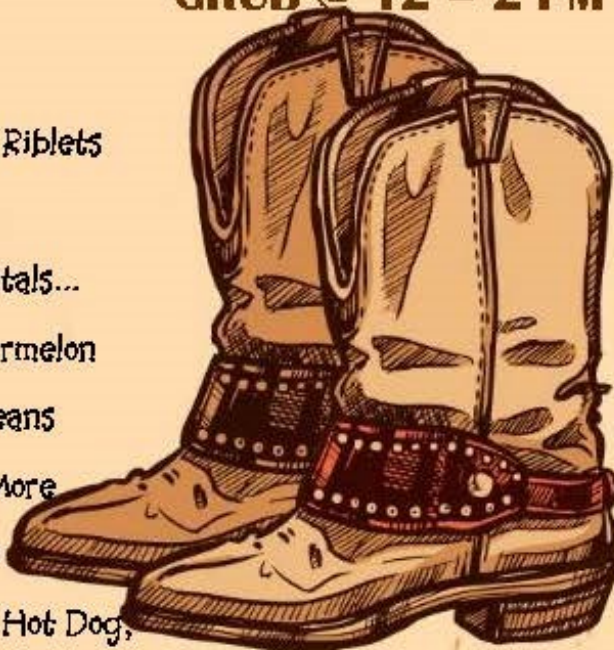

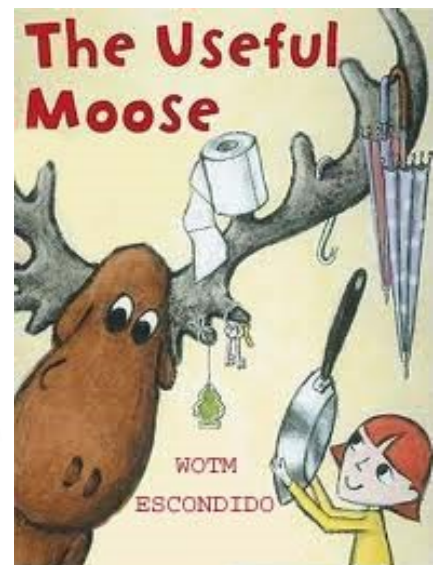
