Once again it is time for an update on what is going on.

The Pre-Thanksgiving dinner was a great success with a good turnout. Donna Marcus put a great deal of effort to chair that committee and rounded up a lot of people to help. They all worked together and had a wonderful dinner. No one left hungry!

To make sure you are all updated on the details of Lodge operations, the Board of officers appointed me as Administrator and it was ratified at the General Meeting on the 21st of November. Also, Bob Fleck Sr. has been appointed Prelate and Phil Ponto appointed as Treasurer. This fills out the board much better giving us more input for decision making. Please feel free to congratulate them.

On a more serious note, participation in Lodge functions is falling short of what is needed. As you all know, the Lodge is supported through sales in the Social Quarters and food sales. Attendance at the dinners, Friday night dancing and special events has dropped drastically. We try to provide the activities you want at a reasonable price. Patronizing the Lodge fund raising functions is what keeps us afloat.

I have had several people tell me that we are making plenty of money and we don't pay taxes. Only partially true! We make minimal profit so members can enjoy the Lodge at good savings. We don't pay income tax but we do pay all other taxes including sales tax, property tax and any other taxes that apply. For every drink or plate of food we serve we pay sales tax. When you consider the price of your drink realize the state is getting a cut.

Another way we cut cost is by having volunteers provide service at no cost. Everyone is a volunteer. NO ONE IN THIS LODGE OR CHAPTER GETS PAID! And, we could use some help. It is fun to be involved and work towards a better Lodge, Social Quarters and environment, but if it is only 10% providing that service all the time it can be tiring. This is your Lodge! Support it by volunteering, attending functions and being involved and you will find it rewarding. I am looking for people to tend bar and wait on tables at dinners and breakfasts. You will meet more of your Brothers and Sisters of the Lodge and have some fun. No experience needed, we will train. Contact me or any board member if interested.

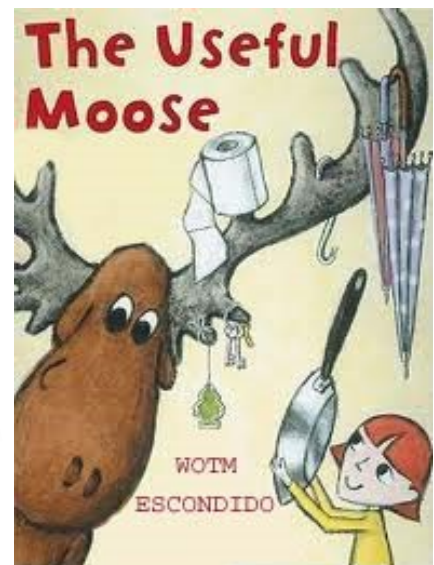
