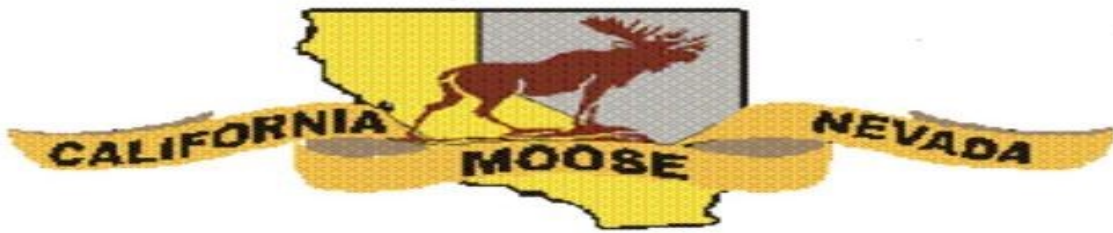

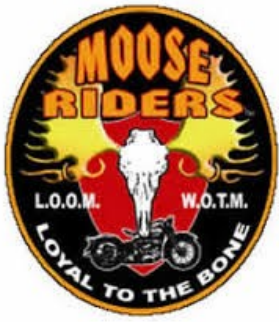
We appreciate the efforts and talents of Jim Trageser for cooking and organizing the Mardi Gras celebration. A great time was had by all that participated!
